Prescription Drug Marketing Act in effect as of September 15, 1992

Dear Customer,

Although QCP has a NO RETURN POLICY for drugs (except in extraordinary circumstances that has satisfied the PDMA and QCP's management approval), we must issue the following certification.

In order to comply with the provisions of the Prescription Drug Marketing Act of 1987 (PDMA) and state licensing requirements, wholesale distributors must evaluate the condition of prescription drugs being returned. If there is any question as to the drug's safety, identity, strength, quality or purity, the drug will be returned to the manufacturer or destroyed.

The fact that the product has been out of the wholesaler's control for some period of time prevents the wholesaler from attesting to the products' condition other than through a visual inspection.

For this reason, effective Monday, September 14, 1992, when a credit return authorization form is returned to the Distribution Center, with merchandise in Class 477 (insulin), Class 800 (pharmacy related items), a signed pharmacy certification form must be attached to each credit return authorization form.

The "Pharmacy Product Certification Form" certifies that the product was stored under proper conditions and has not been misbranded, adulterated or otherwise tampered with. A failure or refusal to sign this certification will result in the merchandise not being accepted by our driver for return to the Distribution Center.
